



## Getting to and from Athens International Airport to the centre of Athens and Meeting venue, by Metro, train & express bus

### **BY METRO AND/OR SUBURBAN RAILWAY**

**The easiest & fastest way:**

**Airport to the centre of Athens, Monastiraki (and vice versa): in only 45 minutes!**

\* By Metro Line 3 (Blue Line), (best option) which starts from the airport and gets you directly to the centre of Athens. In order to reach the meeting venue, you must get off the metro at **Megaron Moussikis** station and from there it is only a 5-7 min walking distance.

\* By Suburban Railway leaving from the airport and connecting with Metro Line 3 (Blue Line) at **Plakendias** station, where you must change to Metro Line 3 (Blue Line). In order to reach the meeting venue, you must get off the metro at **Megaron Moussikis** station and from there it is only a 5-7 min walking distance.

\* By train (Metro or Suburban, alternating) every 15 minutes. It would be advisable to ask to the information desk which is which, in order to know how to proceed.

**Please note that Metro (or Metro & Suburban rail) tickets to the Airport (and vice versa) cost 6.00(€) euros one-way, 10.00(€) euros return.**

### **BY BUS**

Buses leave from **Door 5** of the Arrivals level.

Bus tickets cost **2.90 (€) Euros** and are valid on all means of public transportation for 24 hours (but usable only for one trip to or from the airport). The same ticket can be used for the entire journey or a bit of sightseeing on the way!

**X94 Express bus to the Metro station, (Ethiniki Amyna)** on the signs, better known as **Pentagono** (travelling time: 50-70 minutes).

\* First bus commences at 07.30 and the last bus at 21.55 (frequency 10-20 minutes).

\* Take Metro Line 3 with direction to **Monastiraki**, and get off at **Megaron Moussikis** station.

\* From there it is only a 5-7 min walking distance to the meeting venue.

**X95 Express bus to the centre, (Syntagma)** (average travelling time: 70-90 minutes).

Every 10-30 minutes, 24 hours a day (travelling time: 70-80 minutes).

Connects with Metro Lines 2 & 3.

\* From **Syntagma** take Metro Line 3 with direction **Plakendias**, and get off the metro at **Megaron Moussikis** station

\*From there it is only a 5-7 min walking distance to the meeting venue.

## **BY TAXI**

### **Taxis at the airport**

There is a taxi rank at **Door 3** of the Arrivals level. Taxis cost about **30 (€) Euros** to the centre; **35 (€) Euros** to Piraeus - plus 3 (€) Euros airport surcharge (the meter stays at tariff 1 for these trips, except after midnight, when tariff 2 applies). Taxis charge **0.30 (€) euros** more for each piece of luggage over 10 kilos.

**Recommendation:** Try to adjust your position in the taxi line to coincide with a newer looking taxi - whether you get into a shiny new Mercedes or a battered old Fiat, you pay the same rate.

## **WEATHER IN ATHENS (October)**

Based on previous years statistics the weather in Athens during fall season is mainly pleasant and cool, but windy and rainy at times. Usually spring and fall (autumn) are considered ideal seasons for sightseeing and all kinds of outdoor activities. Below you can see the maximum and minimum degrees weather in Athens can reach at that time of year:
